DAY SEVEN QUESTIONS

“The Wisdom of Naomi”

1. Read Isaiah 61:10. How does Isaiah describe the bride and groom to here?
2. A lot of planning goes into a wedding. From the biggest detail to the smallest, everything is considered. In the same way, our Father has been preparing for our wedding feast since before time began. No detail has escaped Him. All the things that need to occur in order for the wedding to take place, He has considered and prepared for. He knew that, on our own, we couldn't afford the garments we would need for this much anticipated event, so He provided them. He clothes US in righteousness; we bring NOTHING to the marriage, except ourselves.
3. Read 1 Peter 2:22-24. Whose sin did He bear on the cross? What do we receive out of this “transaction”?
4. Although He had committed no sin, He bore OUR sin, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. He, quite seriously, traded us. Not only did He take our sins; He gave US HIS righteousness. How does that impact you to know that He loved YOU so much that He was willing to cover the sins you committed yesterday, the sins you commit today, and the ones you'll commit tomorrow.....and He will forgive and cover you with His righteousness as well?

5. Read 1 Peter 1:8-9. Can it be said of you that you rejoice with joy that is inexpressible? Do you love Him although you have not seen Him?

6. Now, read 1 Peter 1:3-9. Write these verses out (yes, write, don't type 'em) and replace each of the following words with YOUR name: "us" "you" "your". (Fix the verb tenses to agree if you want to .:D) Have you accepted Christ so that what you just wrote is true? Have YOU been caused to be born again? You have an inheritance that is imperishable! Rejoice in the kind of love the Father has given to you, that YOU may be called His child!
