### Day 5: Why do you remain silent?

Habakkuk 1:12-17

- **Habakkuk’s Second Complaint:** Habakkuk then asks how God can punish Judah with an even more evil nation.
- **He remembers what he knows of God:**
  - **Everlasting:** Ps. 90:2; Heb. 1:10-12
  - **LORD:** Ex. 3:13-15
  - **Holy One:** Lev. 11:44-45; Mark 1:23-24; John 6:67-69
  - **Rock:** Deut. 32:4; Ps. 18:2
  - **Purer eyes than to see evil:** Ps. 5:4-6
- **He describes the exploits of the Babylonians and their self-glory.**
- **He asks when will God act to bring the wicked Babylonians to justice.**

**Assignment:** Consider the character of God and the evil in our world.
