



Lesson Eight: "Heard of God" hears from God

Read John 10:25-30. Jesus tells us that He is the shepherd. If we are His sheep, what will we hear and recognize? What will we do when we hear Him? What does He promise to His sheep?

Read Leviticus 26:3-13 and Deuteronomy 7:11-16. In these verses, we see the benefits of following God. List some of the benefits of listening to His commands.

Read Exodus 15:25-26. What does God promise to do if the people listen and obey Him?

Read Leviticus 26:14-22, 2 Kings 18:11-12, Psalm 81:11-13 and Jeremiah 7:13-15. In these verses, we are told what will happen if we do not listen to God. List some consequences of refusing to listen to Him.

Read Matthew 17:1-7. God tells us specifically to listen to someone here. Who should we listen to?

Read 2 Timothy 4:1-2 and Titus 3:1-2. What are we to be ready for?

Read Luke 12:35-36, Matthew 24:36-44, Matthew 25:1-13. What is coming that are we to be in constant readiness for?

Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17. According to this, what is all Scripture for?

The only way to know our Shepherd's voice, to know how to be ready for whatever is to come, is to know His Word. Spend time with God today, asking Him to give you a hunger for His Word, so that you may know His voice when He speaks to you.
