



### **Lesson Nine: The Young Prophet of the Lord**

Read John 16:29-33. What will we have in this world? Why should we take heart?

Read 2 Corinthians 4:7-18. In verses 8-9, there is a list of things that we “are”. Each of these has a “but” which follows it. List these 4 pairs.

What is the hope we are given in verse 16?

Read Isaiah 6:8-9. What is Isaiah’s response when God asks “Whom shall I send?” Isaiah didn’t know where he was going to be sent when God asked this question. All he knew was that God needed to send someone, and Isaiah answered the call.

Read Genesis 22:9-14, Genesis 31:11-13, Genesis 46:1-4, Exodus 3:2-6, and Acts 9:10-12. Who said “Here I am” in response to God in each of these passages?

We all have to make the choice, every day, who we shall listen to. Will we listen to what our society or culture is telling us is right, or will we listen to our creator? Who will we believe regarding the differences between the sexes, what is true or false, and what is good and evil? Is your response “Speak Lord for I am listening” or are you still finding excuses for why you don’t have to listen to Him? If you haven’t already begun, it’s time to start training yourself to recognize His voice. It’s time to be ready to say “Speak, Lord, for I am listening.”
