Read Romans 1:18-22. What has God made clear to man since the creation of the world? How does that impact the excuse of “I didn’t know”?

Read Romans 2:1-11. Who will escape judgment? (Hint: check verse 11)

Read Romans 2:12-16, and Romans 3:21-31. If God doesn’t show partiality, and all men will be judged, how can we hope to enter into heaven?

Saul lived his life and tried to stay out of God’s way. What do these verses tell about how well it works to try to stay out of God’s way?

Where are you trying to “stay out of God’s way” today? Is there something that you are hoping God will overlook in your life, ‘cuz you’re “better than” that guy over there? Remember, there is no place for boasting in yourself. Without Christ’s blood covering you, you are still dead in your sin?
