



**Lesson 66: 1 Samuel 29:1-11 David is excused from fighting**

Read Psalm 32:8-11. Who will teach us the way we should go?

What should we not be like when this teaching is given?

What surrounds those who trust in the Lord?

When we trust in the Lord, what can we rejoice in?

Read Psalm 37:5. What does it mean to commit your way to the Lord?

When you trust Him, and are committed and lined up with Him, what will He do?

Read Psalm 112:6-8. Why will those who are righteous in His sight not fear bad news?

Read Psalm 20:1-2. Read these verses today as a prayer to your Father. Ask Him to protect you, to send you sanctuary, and to answer you in the day of trouble. Remember, when we align ourselves with Him and ask Him for anything that is within His will, He is faithful and will provide.

As you spend time with God today, ask yourself if your heart is steady and firm in the Lord. Are you lined up with Him, or are you expecting Him to line up with you? Ask Him to show you where He wants you to go, and then go there. Ask Him to show you where you are not trusting Him today, and are trying to do things your own way. Repent, and ask Him to help you get back in line with Him so you can forward, trusting in Your Father, rejoicing that He is good and knowing that you need not fear bad news, because He is with you.
