### **Lesson Ninety: 2 Samuel 11:6-13 Maybe No One will Know**

Read Exodus 20:16. What does it mean to be a false witness?

Read Proverbs 19:9 According to this Proverb, what will happen to the one who lies?

Read John 8:42-47. If we lie, according to Jesus, who is our true father? Why?

If we are of God, what will we hear?

Read Colossians 3:8-10. Why, according to Paul, is it natural that we should no longer lie?

Whose image are we being remade into?

Read Psalm 7:12-13. What does God prepare to do to those who do not repent?

Read Ezekiel 18:30-32 and Luke 15:1-7. Because God will judge us all, what do we need to do?

What does God take no pleasure in?

According to the passage in Luke, what is the reaction in heaven over a repentant sinner?

Why should that make it easier for us to approach God with whatever sins we have committed?

Read Matthew 3:1-3. What was the message John the Baptist came to preach?

Read Mark 6:7-13. As Jesus sent the twelve apostles out, what message were they giving?

Read Acts 2:37-39. What did Peter tell the people they must do to be saved?

Read 2 Corinthians 7:9-11. Why does Paul say he is thankful that the Corinthian church was grieved with a godly grief?

As you spend time with God today, remember that you can always come to Him with your sins and confess and be forgiven. Ask Him to help you to be

convinced of the truth He shared in Luke and Ezekiel, that He does not take pleasure in punishing sin. Confess your sins to Him today. Make sure that there is nothing separating you from Him as you draw near to Him. Thank Him for His word and ask Him to put within you a heart for repentance, that you may draw ever nearer to Him, every day.
