Lesson 75: 2 Samuel 3:2-22 Strange Bedfellows

Read Genesis chapter 1. As you read, pick *one* thing that God created and consider all that had to go into creating that item/creature.

List 10 things that went along with creating that creature/item.

Read Psalm 8:3-4. What has God set in the heavens?

Based on whatever knowledge you have from school days of old, what must all happen in order for a star to exist and not to destroy anything around it? (Think gravity, atoms, mass, heat, etc.)

Read Luke 12:4-7. What are we told to fear here?

Why should we be comforted knowing that God knows of every sparrow bought or sold and every hair upon your head at any given time?

Read Job 14:5. Can you add to the days that God has given you to live?

Read Job 38. Again, consider the point God is making here. He created everything and took care of all He details to make it all work perfectly. What does that tell you about how much more He cares for you?

Read Matthew 6:25-34. What should we seek first?

What will happen then?

Is God promising to give you whatever your heart desires?

How do you know?

As you spend time with God today, ask Him to help you to give to Him all the details that you are anxious about.

Ask Him to remind you that He is in control and there is no detail of your life, great or small (down to how many hairs you lost today!) that He isn't aware of.

Look to Him for your strength and salvation today, and follow where He leads you!
