Ten generations named: representative; from Adam to Noah: Luke 3:36-38; part of Christ's genealogy

God named them Man: made them in the image of God: Mark 10:6; God declares His own dominion over all creation

Pattern of descendants: name, fathered a certain son, had other son and daughters, days were a certain number of years, and he died

Enoch: seventh generation, exception to "and he died"; "Enoch walked with God, and he was not, for God took him." 2 Kings 2:11; Heb. 11:5-6; Jude 14, 15; Lev. 26:3, 12

This one shall bring us relief: Noah (rest): Heb. 11:7
