Sarai's Plan: obtain children by Hagar: Gen. 2:18, 24; Prov. 3:5-6

Abram agreed: followed Sarai's advice: Gen. 3:17; Deut. 17:17

Hagar looked with contempt: to esteem lightly, to despise: Prov. 13:10

Sarai blamed Abram: he absolved responsibility, Sarai dealt harshly with (anah:

afflicted) Hagar: Gen. 15:13; Ex. 1:11-12

Hagar fled: Hagar means *flight*. 1 Pet. 2:18-19

Angel of the LORD: preincarnate Christ: Josh. 5:13-15; found Hagar and called her by name and position. Note his two questions, two commands and two promises.

Hagar's response: called LORD "God who sees me," returned and bore Ishmael (*God hears*)

How did the LORD show grace to Hagar?

How did Hagar respond to the LORD in faith?
