Day 29: Genesis 17:1-27: Abraham and the Covenant of Circumcision

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God Almighty: El Shaddai: Abundant or All-sufficient One

Walk before me: be blameless; in an ongoing manner without blemish: Gen. 5:22; 6:9; this new covenant involves conditions

Father of a multitude of nations: Abram (*exalted father*) changed to Abraham (*father of many, of a multitude*): Gen. 12:3; Rev. 7:9

Everlasting Covenant: to be God to you and your offspring; for Canaan to be an everlasting possession: Rom. 4:17-25

Circumcision: a sign of the covenant (*karat berith; lit. "to cut a covenant"*) in which males cut away, put to death their sinful natures and depend upon God for the production of all life and especially the promised seed

Uncircumcised heart: unbelief: Jer. 9:26; Ezek. 44:7-9; God would circumcise their hearts: Deut. 30:6; Rom. 4:9-12

Sarai (*my princess)*: changed to Sarah (*princess*), will bear a son and be mother of nations and kings

Abraham laughed: reaction to the improbability of their having a son?

Sarah will bear Isaac (*he laughs*): God will establish an everlasting covenant with Isaac rather than Ishmael

Abraham obeyed: all males circumcised that very day
