DAY 27 Galatians 5:22-23

Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness

Ephesians 4:31-32. What should be put away from us, as followers of Christ? How should we treat each other? What model do we have for this?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4. How is love described positively here?

Read 2 Timothy 2:24-26. How is the shepherd not to act? How is he to act? For what purpose?

Read Ephesians 2:4-9. What demonstrates God's kindness toward us?

Read Titus 3:4-7. Again, what is a demonstration of God's kindness here?

Read John 10:27-30. How is this an example of God's faithfulness?

Read 1 Corinthians 10:13. What example of God's faithfulness do we see here?

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24. What can we have confidence God is faithful to do?

Read 2 Timothy 2:11-13. Does God's faithfulness depend on our faithfulness? Why?

Read Matthew 25:20-29. What commendation was given to the first two servants? What future promise goes with that?

As you spend time with God today, ask God to help you to demonstrate kindness and goodness to other believers, and to those nonbelievers around you. Ask God to help you to be steadfast, to hold to His word and truth, to be reliable and trustworthy in your words and deeds. Ask Him to help you to be more aware of ways in which you might be untrustworthy. Then, thank Him for His kindness, goodness and faithfulness to you.
