



Paul's Letter to the Galatians

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Day 11 Galatians 3:21-25

Do you love His Law?

Okay, today we're gonna do things a wee bit differently. *Read through Psalm 119.* All of it. All 176 verses. As you do that, underline or circle or make note somehow of how many times the following words appear: commands, commandments, rules, statutes, word, precepts, law, and testimonies.

As you find these words, look at the context of them and write down how the Psalmist views God's word/commands. (Example: verse 2 says those who keep His testimonies are blessed, so you might write "testimonies: blessed".)

As you go throughout this Psalm, consider how God's word is viewed by the Psalmist. Then ask yourself how you feel about God's commands. Do you see His word as a delight? Do you see those who keep His testimonies as blessed? Are His commands more precious to you than gold or silver? Are His commands sweeter than honey to your mouth? Do you see His precepts as the way to gain understanding?

Now, finally, *read Ezekiel 36:26-27.* What does God do to enable us to walk in His statutes and obey His rules? Is this something we can do to ourselves?

As you spend time with God today, consider how precious God's law is to the Psalmist. Ask God to help you to love His word and His commands like that. Ask Him to help you to obey His commands, to keep your feet walking in His statutes. Thank Him for providing a way for us to obey His commands. Ask Him to help you to hide His word in your heart so that you may not sin against Him as you grow in love for His commands daily.
