Day 31 Galatians 6:6-18

Do Not Be Deceived

Read Matthew 7:15-20. What should we beware of? How will we recognize them?

Read 1 Timothy 1:3-4. What should not be taught? What do those things promote?

Read 1 Timothy 6:3-10. What does Paul tell Timothy is true of those who teach a different, unsound doctrine? What craving might these false teachers have? What does Paul encourage the people to acquire (verse 6, 8)? Why might those who desire to be rich fall into temptation?

Read 2 Peter 2:1-3. What does Peter warn will rise among the people? Will this be attractive to at least some of the people?

Read Romans 2:6-11. What will God render to each one? Who will receive eternal life? Who will receive wrath and fury?

As you spend time with God today, ask Him for wisdom and discernment in your daily life to avoid the pitfalls and traps that are out there. Ask Him to help you to hunger and thirst for His word so that you will know it for yourself and will not be led astray by false teaching. Consider the warnings throughout Scripture and ask Him to help you to truly serve Him without adding other requirements to salvation. Ask Him to help you to be light and salt to the world, to shine in the darkness. And, if you haven't already done so, give your entire life to Him, offer yourself as a living sacrifice for His will and for His glory starting today and for the rest of your life. Ask Him to give you the strength and courage to "rock the boat" when He calls you to it, for His glory, so that His name might be proclaimed among the nations, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!"
