Day 8 Galatians 3:5-9

Counted as Righteousness

Read Isaiah 64:1-7. What characteristics of God are highlighted in this passage? According to verse 5, what is a description of one who works righteousness? What are all of our righteous deeds like, in comparison to God's righteousness?

Read Romans 4:2-3. Who is talking about here? What is counted to him as righteousness? What, by contrast, was *not* counted to him as righteousness?

Read Romans 10:14-17. A progression of events is laid out here, but it is backward. What is the progression of events, from step 1 to the final step? What is Paul's conclusion of where faith comes from in verse 17?

Read Romans 8:29-33. Here we find a "list" if you will of things that God has done for believers. List the 5 things that God has done for believers here.

Read Romans 5:1-2. Through what are we justified? What peace is wrought in this? What other "benefits" of faith do we have?

Today, as you spend time with God, consider all the benefits that you have received, having been justified by faith in Christ. Thank Him for all those amazing gifts, given to you through His grace. Thank Him for grafting you in to His family, adopting you as His precious child, and thank Him for the continuing sanctification that He provides for you every day.
