Day 52: Genesis 36:1-43: Esau's descendants

These are the generations of Esau: 3 or 4 wives; 5 sons; produced 14 chiefs; compare to the generations of Ishmael: Gen. 25:12-18

Esau settled in Seir: which became Edom; southwest of the Dead Sea: Gen. 27:39-40; given to Esau by God: Deut. 2:5; Josh. 24:4

Seir the Horite: initial inhabitant of Seir; 5 chiefs; Esau's clan dominated

These are the kings: 7 generations named; "before any king reigned over the Israelites" prophetically points to kings in Israel: Gen. 25:23

Assignment: Why was it part of God's plan for Esau to settle away from Canaan and his brother Jacob?

How did the LORD bless Esau and his descendants?

Read Ex. 17:8-16 and Deut. 25:17-19 which recount the conflict between Israel and the descendants of Esau's grandson Amalek. What happened to Amalek as a consequence of their actions?

Knowing that God works differently in each person's life, how can you praise the Lord today for his blessing and care in your life?
