
Day 59: Genesis 42:1-38: Joseph's Brothers Go to Egypt

- Jacob sent ten brothers to Egypt to buy food: Benjamin kept home
- **Brothers bowed before Joseph:** he knew them but treated them as strangers; accused them of being spies; remembered his dreams
- If you are honest men: bring your youngest brother to me; Simeon confined in Egypt
- Brothers realized their troubles: God's doing for their mistreatment of Joseph
- Jacob and his sons afraid: found money in each man's sack; Jacob feared losing Benjamin also
