- **Israel:** directed: go buy more food; if it must be so take Benjamin, double the money, and some choice fruits of the land with you
- Judah: repeated what the man said; declared he would be a pledge of Benjamin's safety
- **Jacob's response**: May God Almighty grant you mercy before the man, and may he send back your other brother and Benjamin
- **Brothers and Benjamin:** stood before Joseph and he unexpectedly prepared a generous meal for them in his house
- **Brothers:** afraid because of money found in sacks after first visit; reassured by steward; Simeon brought out to them; they bowed to Joseph
- **Joseph:** gracious to brothers, wept because of compassion for Benjamin
- **Dining with Joseph:** brothers seated in order of birth; portions taken from Joseph's table for them with Benjamin receiving five times as much
