- Jacob offered sacrifices at Beersheba: God appeared to him and promised to go with him to Egypt, to make him into a great nation and to bring him up again
- Register of family: sons and grandchildren listed; in all 70 in Egypt
- Jacob and Joseph reunited: Joseph fell on his neck and wept
- Instructions about meeting Pharaoh: say your servants have been keepers of livestock so you may live in the land of Goshen
