**ONAOMI'S TABLE 2016**

**Day 6: Ephesians 3:1-13 United in Christ**

**Read Psalm 133:1-3.** How does David describe unity among brothers here?

**Read Romans 6:5-14.** What unity is being described in these verses? Because of this unity, what are we no longer slaves to? Why do we believe we will also live with Christ? In order to be alive to God in Christ Jesus, what must we do? What “conclusion” does Paul make in verses 12-14? What does that look like in your life?

**Read 1 Peter 3:8-9.** What does Peter tell us should be united in believers?

**Read Galatians 3:7-9.** What type of unity was predicted in Scripture with Abraham?

**Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27.** How does Paul describe the church here? What is he warning against? What is he encouraging them to do?

As you spend time with God today, ask Him to help you to see where you are failing to seek unity because of your own pride or selfish agenda. Thank Him for providing His body to care for the members and encourage and lift each other up, and ask Him to help you to have wisdom to know how to be united with the body of believers you worship with. If there is a conflict that you have with another brother or sister, don't wait to address it.

Ask God to give you a desire to seek reconciliation and to help you to know how to approach that. Ask Him to give you the desire for unification in His Son, loving your brothers and sisters and being ready to encourage and exhort and to rebuke as needed too.
