Day 9: Ephesians 4:7-10 Amazing Grace

Read Hebrews 12:1-2. What are we to lay aside? (Two things) What will this enable us to do? Who are we to look to? How did He perceive the cross? What role does Jesus play in our faith, according to verse 2?

Read Romans 5:6-11. What state were we in when Christ died for us? Why is this noteworthy? How does God show His love for us? What will we be saved from? What do we also rejoice in?

Read 2 Corinthians 12:7-10. What was Paul given? Why? What did he plead with God? What response did he get? What was Paul's response to that? In what is Paul content? How can that possibly be true?

Read Galatians 3:10-14. Can we be justified before God by the law? What did Christ become in our place? What might the Gentiles receive because of this?

As you spend time with God today, consider the words of the first and last verse of this song by Charles Wesley.
