Day 9: Woe to the Chaldeans

Habakkuk 2:6-13

- 539 BC: Babylon conquered by the Medes and Persians (Daniel Chapter 5)
- Woe: interjection of distress pronounced in the face of disaster or coming judgment because of sin (lsa. 5:8-23)
- Principle of reaping what is sown: Prov. 22:8; Gal. 6:7-8

Assignment: Note the sins of Babylon, the contrasts between self-glory and God's glory and repeated words. Read Isaiah Chapter 47.
