



Lesson 11: Judgment on Eli's house

Read Psalm 9:7-8. Who judges the earth? With what does He judge?

Read 2 Timothy 4:1 Who will be judged? Who does this exclude?

Read Romans 2:12-16. On "that day" what will God judge? (Not who, but what?)

Read Matthew 12:36-37. What of our own will condemn us on judgment day? (hint: something that is careless)

Read Romans 14:10-12. What will we all have to give to God?

Read Hebrews 10:26-31. If we go on sinning deliberately (as Eli's sons did), what can we expect? What is it a "fearful" thing to do? (verse 31)

Read 2 Peter 3:8-10. Instead of viewing God as slow to exact His justice, what does Peter say God is?

We have no secrets from God; He knows them all. One day, we will have to give an accounting to the judge for all the things that we've done....even the things only He and you know about.

As you ponder that today, take some time and thank God for His grace that covers all your sin; especially the ones only He knows about. Remember that His grace is a free gift, not because you deserve. Consider how precious that gift is to you, and what an amazing God we serve!
