



Lesson 12: The ark goes sightseeing

Read the following verses: Exodus 7:4-5, Exodus 33:17-22, Psalm 37:23-24, Psalm 44:1-3, Psalm 63:8, Psalm 145:14-16, Isaiah 41:11-13, Isaiah 48:12-13, and John 10:25-30.

Each of these verses refers to the hand of the Lord in different ways. What ways do we see the hand of Lord in these verses? (examples: distributing justice, giving protection, etc.)

Read Isaiah 29:15-16. According to these verses, can you hide your deeds from God? Can you tell God how to act or what to do?

We know that we cannot manipulate God (see day 10). We know that He is in control. After reading these verses today, make a list of where you have seen His hand in your life in the various ways described in the above verses. Where have you seen His hand of protection? Where have you seen His hand of justice? As you look at that list, remember that it is not for your glory that He does these things; it is not with your hand that you are protected, but with His. Spend some time with Him today thanking Him for all the ways His hands have worked for His glory in your life.
