



Lesson Five: Favored little boy

Read John 14:15-31. Jesus promises to send someone to help us. Who does He promise to send? Who will be the ones who love Him? (verse 21) Where do we find His commandments?

Considering this passage in John 14, from Jesus' own words, how does God speak to us today?

Read Matthew 11:25-30. How does Jesus describe Himself in verse 29? What does He promise to those who come to Him?

Read Zechariah 9:9 and Matthew 21:1-11. How did Zechariah predict the Messiah would come into Jerusalem? How did Christ come in to Jerusalem?

Jesus came to us "gentled" on a donkey as a king, not riding loud and triumphantly into Jerusalem. He did not come as the human kings would come, with a fanfare and heralds announcing their arrival as they came riding in on an amazing steed, full of pomp and glory and surrounded by an impressive army. What does that tell you about what Christ's mission was about?

Read 1 Corinthians 1:26-31. What "things" did God choose to work through? Why?

Consider today, what are your weaknesses? Where are the things that you struggle with consistently? Are you still trying to "fix" those yourself? When will you give those over to God? Let today be the day when you accept His yoke and give up your heavy burden to Him.
