### **Lesson 84: 2 Samuel 7:18-29 Who Am I?**

Today, I have simply some introspective heart questions for you to consider.

When God says “no” to you, do you accept that answer, or do you get cranky and whiny and demand a reason?

When God says “no” or even “not right now”, do you trust His wisdom, or insist that your way is right?

When God says “no” do you doubt that He wants your best, that His desire isn't to bring you harm?

Do you expect a “yes” to every prayer? Do you expect God to conform His will to your grand plan?

At the root of it, when you don't accept His answer, you're telling God that you would do a better job of being in control, and that you don't trust God to take care of you. For today, I'm simply listing several verses that will (hopefully!) encourage you to trust your Father, to know that He does have your best interest at heart, that He wants to grow you and shape you to be more like Him.
