



Lesson 69: 1 Samuel 31:1-13 Farewell to the King

Read Psalm 5:4-6. What does God *not* delight in?

What does God hate (more than one thing listed)?

Read Psalm 92:15. What is missing from God?

Read Isaiah 59:1-4. What is the result of sin in our lives?

Because of our sins, what can we not enter justly?

What kind of a “suit” is being described here?

What role would you play in this courtroom scene?

What role does God play?

Read Romans 3:21-26. According to these verses, what have we all done?

What is the solution to this problem? (verse 24)

Read Romans 6:23. What is the consequence of our sin?

Read Romans 10:8-13. What must you do to be saved?

Read Romans 8:1-8. If we are in Christ Jesus, what are we no longer under?

Who has set us free? Why couldn't we set ourselves free?

As you spend time with God today, ask Him for forgiveness for the sins which you have committed this day. Know that God still looks upon sin as He describes in Psalm, and thank Him for the grace that He has showered upon you in providing for your eternal salvation. Without understanding how God sees our sin, we can't hope to grasp how much we have been forgiven and how much He was willing to sacrifice for us to be brought close to Him. If you haven't accepted that gift yet, don't wait another day. Re-read the verses above in Romans, and see that you owe a debt you cannot hope to pay. Accept the payment He has paid for your salvation today! If you have already accepted that gift, thank Him for that gift today, with joy and gladness, knowing the grace you have been given today!
