Lesson 106: 2 Samuel 17:17-29 Espionage and Respite

As we have been looking at the way in which God takes care of the minute details of David's life to protect and care for him, even when David sins, we see how God has worked everything to His glory and, ultimately, for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purpose. It doesn't mean that what was happening to David was easy, but still, throughout it all, we can see how God kept watch over David. So, today, we're going to focus on Scripture that reminds us to praise our mighty and awesome God for all that He does to save and protect us every single day.

Read Psalm 8:1-9. As David extols God's name, he is aware of how insignificant man is to such a mighty God, yet God still cares for us! What do verses 5-8 tell us about how much He loves us?

Read Psalm 16:1-11. Why does David know that God is his refuge?

Why is David's heart glad?

Read Psalm 29:1-11. What attributes of God does David focus on in this Psalm?

Read Romans 8:31-39. Is there anything for us to fear if God is for us?

Is there anything that can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord?

Read Romans 15:8-13. Why should we, Gentiles, have hope?

Read Romans 16:25-27. Where does our strength come from?

Is that according to our own power or knowledge?

Who should receive all the glory forevermore?

Read Philippians 1:18-21. Why will Paul rejoice?

What does he consider death as?

Read Colossians 1:15-23. As you read this description of Christ, praise God for sending His Son, by whom all things were created in heaven and on earth and under the earth. Praise Him for reconciling you, you personally, to Him through his death on the cross.

Read 1 Timothy 1:12-17. Where does our strength come from?

What were you, personally, formerly, before God claimed you for His own?

Why does God show His mercy?

Read Jude 1:24-25. What is He able to keep you from doing?

What shall be to God for now and forever more?

As you spend time with God today, make your time a time of praise and thanksgiving for the mighty God you serve! Ask him to help you to see His mighty hand at work in your life and thank Him for at least a couple of specific ways that you can see Him working in your life today. Sing, shout and praise your God!
