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Read James 1:13-15. Why should we not say that God is tempting us?

What is the source of our temptation?

What is the chain of events, starting with desire?

What is the result of sin?

Read Colossians 3:5-11. What should we be putting to death in ourselves?

What does Paul say covetousness is?

What is our new self being renewed in the knowledge of?

Read John 3:16-21. How has God shown us that He loves the world?

Why did God send Jesus into the world?

What will happen to those who do not believe in Him?

What is the judgment?

Why do those who do wicked things hate light?

Whoever does *what* is true shows that his works have been carried out how?

Read John 8:34-38. What does Jesus say those who practice (those who make a practice of, intentionally) sin actually is?

Who must set us free from sin?

Based on what model does Jesus speak?

Based on what model do we slaves to sin speak?

Read Matthew 7:15-18. How will we recognize those who are from God and those who are not from God?

What characteristics can you think of that would describe someone who is from God? What characteristics can you think of that would describe someone who is not from God?

Read Romans 5:15-17. Circle every time the words “free gift” appear. Write down characteristics of the free gift.

As you spend time with God today, read Exodus 21:1-6. This passage gives instructions regarding slaves and how long they were allowed to be slaves before they had to be set free, but there is a caveat given in verse 5. As you read this today, consider what you are a slave to...and what you want to be a slave to. Ask God to help you to have the same heart as that of the slave in verse 5, loving God and not desiring to go free to your own devices. Thank Him for the benefits of being His slave, instead of being a slave to sin, and thank Him, one more time (it is never enough!) for the free gift of grace that He has given to you!
