How is our salvation being guarded?

Is it up to *you* to keep your salvation?

1 Corinthians 15:14-17. Why is Christ’s resurrection so important for us to believe and confess?

Read Jonah 3:1-10. What message did Jonah give to the people of Nineveh?

How did the people react?

What was the response of the king?

When God saw the reaction of the people of Nineveh, what did He do?

How does this example of God’s mercy relate to the grafting in of the Gentiles to salvation?

Read Galatians 3:28-29. What is the conclusion of the statement that all are one in Christ?

Read Ephesians 2:11-13. What was the previous fate of the Gentiles?

What have the Gentiles been given in Christ?

How has He broken down the all of hostility?
