Lot's sons-in-law: thought him to be jesting: Luke 17:26-30

Lot lingered: attached to wicked city

The LORD being merciful to him: brought him out: Matt. 11:23-24

Lot's wife: looked back; Jesus notes her lack of faith: Luke 17:32

God remembered Abraham: spared Lot and sent him out

Sin in the cave: drunkenness, incest: result is Moab and Ammon; enemies of Israel

Assignment:

Consider the severity of God's wrath against Sodom and Gomorrah's evil, and his mercy to Lot and his family. Have you thought lately about the mercy and grace God has shown/continues to show you? Why is it important to remember this?

Why did Lot's wife turn back? Have you ever "looked back" at the things you have given up to follow Christ? (Read Phil 3:7-14)

Read Romans 1:18-32. How do you view sin? Are you compromising with the world in any way and tolerating sin in your life? If so, trust what God's word says and repent.
