Sarah lived 127 years: died at Hebron (only woman in Bible whose age at death is recorded)

Abraham mourns: asks the Hittites to sell him property as a burial place

Abraham pays 400 pieces of silver: field and cave made over to him

Sarah buried: in cave, only land that Abraham owned in Canaan

Abraham's servant: Eliezer of Damascus: Gen. 15:2-4; swore oath to find a wife for Isaac from Abraham's kindred

Assignment:

Why did Abraham pay a very high price for the burial land? Also, why did Abraham not want a wife for Isaac from the daughters of Canaan?

Why did Abraham not want Isaac to return to Mesopotamia?

What was the source of Abraham's confidence that his servant would be successful?
