## Day 20 Galatians 5:19

### ***Pardon Me, Your Works are Showing***

*Read Romans 8:5-8.* Why should we be concerned if we are walking in our flesh?

*Read Romans 13:12-14.* What should we cast off? How should we not walk? What should we put on? What should we make no allowance or justification for?

*Read Ephesians 5:3-6.* What is not proper among the saints? What else is out of place? What can we be sure of? Why is the wrath of God coming upon the people who walk in darkness?

*Read Colossians 3:5-10.* What should we put to death? Again, why is the wrath of God coming? Even though these things might have described you in the past, we are to put them away now and what are we to put on? What are we being renewed in?

*Read 1 Thes 4:3-7.* What has God called us for? What must we exhibit control over?

*Read 1 Corinthians 6:18-20.* What does Paul say our reaction to sexual immorality should be? Paul gives several "why" reasons. What are they? Why should those reasons have an impact on how we view sexual immorality?

*Read Hebrews 12:5-6.* Why should we accept the discipline and correction that we receive from God?

As you spend time with God today, thank Him for being a God who does treat us as His children, who does discipline us and correct us when we sin. If there is unrepentant sexual immorality in your life, please don't ignore it any longer. Confess that to God and repent of that. Agree with Him that it was sin, and ask Him for forgiveness, and let that burden be removed from you today.
