Day 21 Galatians 5:20

Idols, Hatred, Discord

Read 1 Corinthians 10:7-8. What warning does Paul give the people here?

Read Colossians 2:18-19. How does Paul describe these “mystical” acts in verse 18? Why is this a concern?

Read Colossians 3:8. Again, what are we to put away?

Read Matthew 5:21-22. What does Jesus say is on par with murder?

Read Matthew 6:9-15. How are we to forgive, according to verse 12? How do we know that forgiveness is serious business?

Read Ephesians 4:31-32. What should we put aside? What contrasting behavior does Paul give here?

Read 1 John 2:9-11. What does John say about what part hatred has with our walk with God?

Read Titus 3:1-3. How are the people urged to behave? What actions characterized their past, before Christ?

As you spend time with God today, consider what idols you have in your life. Are you harboring hatred and withholding forgiveness from someone? Are you fighting or arguing with someone? Are you dwelling in “if only”? Ask God to help you to see where you are putting other things before Him; where you are withholding forgiveness and where you are allowing bitterness to take root as you live in “if only”. Confess those areas to Him and repent. We all have so much growing still to do while we are in these earthly “tents”. Don’t be discouraged by the sin in your life; be grateful that He is faithful to forgive you when you confess your sins!
