



Paul's Letter to the Galatians

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Day 26 Galatians 5:22-23

Have Patience

Read Psalm 37:5-7. Who should we trust? What are we to do before the Lord?

Read Luke 8:11-15. Jesus explains the parable of the sower here. Which "soil" is associated with patience? What do the people who receive the word as that soil demonstrate?

Read Romans 2:3-8. Who exhibits patience in verse 4? What is that patience meant for? Who exhibits patience in verse 7? What does that bring?

Read 2 Peter 3:9-10. Peter says that the Lord is not delaying keeping His promises but is doing what? Peter assures the reader that what *will* still happen?

Read Romans 12:9-12. How are we to love? How are we to serve the Lord? What are we to be patient in?

Read Ephesians 4:1-3. How are we to relate to other believers?

Read Colossians 1:11-12. Where do we receive the strength to be patient? What goes along with patience here? How does joy fit in here?

Read Hebrews 6:11-12. How do we inherit the promises?

As you spend time with God today, consider how patient He is with humanity and thank Him for His patience and mercy toward sinners like us. Ask Him to help you to understand what true patience looks like, both in times of trial and in times of peace. Ask Him to help you to trust Him and to wait upon His timing with peace and joy. Ask Him to help His patience to flow out of you into your daily reactions as well. If there are any situations where you find that your patience is more likely to evaporate than others, take those situations to God. Ask Him to help you to rely on Him in those times, instead of simply reacting. Repent of any sin that may be hiding in your heart, and cling to His promises of our eternal hope.
