Jacob divided his family: put Joseph and Rachel in the safest place

Jacob went before his family: bowing seven times

But Esau ran to meet him: embraced him, fell on his neck, kissed him and wept: Luke 15:20

Accept my present: accept my blessing because God has dealt graciously with me

Seen your face: like seeing the face of God; you have accepted me: Num. 6:24-26

Jacob declined: Esau's offer to travel with him or provide men for trip

But Jacob went to Succoth: rather than Seir; built a house & booths

Later came to Shechem: bought land; built an altar (place of Abram's first altar)

What are the similarities between Jacob and the Prodigal Son in Luke 15?
