- The LORD was with Joseph: successful overseer of household blessed by God: Gen 12:2-3
- **Potiphar's Wife:** attempted to seduce him; continued to proposition him; finally ambushed him; then lied and used his garment as false proof
- **Joseph:** acted with integrity; understood his authority; was loyal to his master; most of all did not want to sin against God: 2 Tim. 2:22
- **Joseph unjustly imprisoned:** but the LORD was with him; showed him steadfast love; gave him favor with the prison keeper; made him succeed

Read Prov. 5:1-23. What are the consequences of sexual sin? What are the benefits of purity and fidelity?
