- Two prisoners: two dreams; two outcomes: cupbearer restored in 3 days, baker executed in 3 days
- **Interpretations belong to God:** Joseph knows God reveals future events through dreams; tells Pharaoh's officers the meaning of their dreams
- Remember me, do me this kindness (chesed): when you are restored to Pharaoh; but the cupbearer forgot

Assignment:

How is God developing Joseph's character through adverse circumstances?

How does Joseph demonstrate on-going trust in God?

The cupbearer forgot Joseph, but how do we know that God will not forget him? (See Gen. 8:1; 19:29; 30:22.)

Have you ever "forgotten" someone's act of kindness to you? Have you ever been "forgotten" by someone who had promised to help you? How did God use either instance to grow your faith and dependence on Him?
