**ONAOMI'S TABLE 2016**

**Day 19: Ephesians 6:10-17 Suit Up, Soldier!**

**Read John 16:12-14.** How does Jesus refer to the Holy Spirit? What does He say the job of the Holy Spirit is?

**Read John 17:14-17.** As Jesus prays for his followers, what does He say will sanctify them? What does He say God's word is?

**Read Romans 1:18-25.** What do unrighteous men do? What is being revealed against them? Why? What did they choose to do, even while they knew God? What did they choose to exchange? What do they worship?

**Read Romans 2:6-8.** What do these verses tell you about how important it is to obey the truth that God gives us?

**Read Luke 11:27-28.** When the woman in the crowd blessed Jesus' mother, what was His response? What does that tell you about the importance of God's word?

**Read Hebrews 4:11-13.** How does the writer of Hebrews describe God's word? What can it discern? What does it expose? In light of this, why might people choose to deny that the Bible is true?

**Read Romans 10:14-17.** According to Paul, how does faith come to a man? Who should they believe in?

**Read Hebrews 11:1-3.** How does the writer of Hebrews describe faith? What can we understand through faith?

**Read Philippians 2:12-13.** What should we continue to work out? Why does God work in us in this way?

**Read 1 Thessalonians 5:8-11.** How does Paul describe the helmet here? What has God destined His chosen for? How do we obtain this? In light of this, what should be our attitude toward other believers?

**Read 1 Peter 1:8-9.** Peter describes how believers should feel toward/consider Christ. How does he describe this? What will be the outcome of your faith?

**Read Romans 3:21-26.** Where do those who believe get their righteousness from? What distinction does Paul say does not exist? Why did God put forth Christ to take our punishment?

**Read Romans 6:15-18.** What does Paul say will lead to righteousness? What have we been set free from?

**Read Romans 1:16-17.** How does Paul feel about the gospel? What is so powerful about the gospel?



As you spend time with God today, thank Him for providing all that you need to suit up for the battle you are already in. Ask Him to help you to keep renewing your mind through His word, growing in faith, righteousness, truth, knowledge of salvation and ask Him to help you to spread the good news to everyone you meet, boldly and with His strength.

Ask Him to help you to be strengthened daily so that you may not live as the unrighteous but as the righteous, called by Him and set apart for His purposes, as His soldier. Remember that the gospel is the gospel of peace between men and God and that message needs to be told to every man that they might be reconciled to Him through faith in Christ, just as you have been reconciled to Him.
