**ONAOMI'S TABLE 2016**

**Day 3: Ephesians 1:15-23 Who Inherits What?**

**Read Deuteronomy 32:8-9, Psalm 135:4, and Malachi 3:17.** What portion has God kept for His own inheritance/treasure?

**Read Romans 10:10-13, 11:11-12, 15:8-13.** Who does Paul tell us is part of Israel?

**Read Ezekiel 36:26-28.** What role does Ezekiel tell us the Spirit will do within us?

**Read Romans 11:30-36.** What, according to Paul, has every man been in the past? What has God chosen to show to us? Is this something that we can fully grasp? Why or why not? What, according to verse 36, does it all come down to?

**Read Philippians 2:5-11.** According to these verses, who was Jesus? What was His attitude? What was His "mission"? What place has God given to Jesus? For what purpose has all this been done?

As you spend time with God today, thank Him for the hope of an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. Praise Him for His grace and mercy, and for providing to us the Holy Spirit to sanctify us and to help us to obey His statutes, not out of fear, but out of gratitude and awe that He would *choose us*. Thank God for knowing the exact Savior we needed and sending Him at the right time, to die in our place. Consider the love that He has for His children that we would be the inheritance He has set aside for Himself! Ask yourself what your reaction should be to Him in light of that truth. Ask Him to continue to humble and sanctify you to draw you nearer to Him every day as He continues to refine you.
